# **COOKIES POLICY**

**DUSCHOLUX IBÉRICA SA,** owner of this Website (hereinafter the OWNER), uses its own and third-party cookies for different purposes. The OWNER uses cookies in order to comply with the legal requirements set out in Law 34/2002, of 11 July, on information society services and electronic commerce (LSSI).

The purpose of this Cookies Policy is to inform you in a clear, precise and complete manner about the cookies we use, the information we collect through them and for what purposes this information is used as established in article 22.2 of the LSSI.

#### 1. WHAT ARE COOKIES AND WHAT IS THEIR PURPOSE?

A "cookie" is a file that is stored on the user's computer, tablet, smartphone or any other device, in order to collect and store information about the user's use of the Website (article 22.2 LSSI).

#### 2. WHO IS RESPONSIBLE?

The cookies used on the website are processed by the OWNER or third parties with their purposes and storage period, established in section four of this cookie policy.

#### 3. WHAT TYPE OF COOKIES ARE THERE?

Below is a classification of the cookies that exist and may be used on our Website, taking into account that the same cookie may be included in more than one category.

- 1) Depending on the **entity that manages them** 
  - <u>First-party cookies</u>: those that are sent to your computer from our own computers or domains and from which we provide the service you request.
  - <u>Third-party cookies</u>: those that are sent to your computer from a computer or domain that is not managed by us, but by another collaborating entity.
- 2) Depending on the **length of time they remain active**

- <u>Session cookies:</u> these are those designed to collect and store data while the The user accesses a web page. They are usually used to store information that is only of interest to be kept for the provision of the service requested by the user on a single occasion (for example, a list of products purchased) and disappear at the end of the session.
- <u>Persistent cookies:</u> these are those in which the data is still stored on the terminal and can be accessed and processed for a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie, which can range from a few minutes to several years.
- 3) Depending on the **purpose** 
  - <u>Technical cookies</u>: these are those that allow navigation through the Website, including those used for the management of the Website and the provision of its functions and services (e.g.: controlling traffic and data communication, identifying the session, accessing parts with restricted access, remembering the elements that make up an order, carry out the purchase process of an order, manage payment, etc.). These cookies will be exempt from complying with the obligations established in article 22.2 of the LSSI when they allow the service requested by the user to be provided. However, if these cookies are used for non-exempt purposes, they will be subject to these obligations.
  - <u>Personalisation cookies:</u> these are those that allow information to be remembered so that you can access the Website with certain characteristics that may differentiate your experience from that of other users (e.g. the language, the number of results to be displayed when the user performs a search, the appearance or content of the service depending on the type of browser through which the user accesses the service or the region from which the user accesses the service, etc.). If it is the user himself who chooses these characteristics (for example, by selecting the language of the website by clicking on the corresponding flag icon), cookies will be exempt from the obligations of article 22.2 of the LSSI as they are considered a service expressly requested by the user, as long as the cookies obey the selected purpose.
  - <u>Analysis or measurement cookies:</u> these are those that allow the person responsible for them to monitor and analyse user behaviour, including quantifying the impacts of advertisements. The information collected through this type of cookie is used to measure the activity of the Website in order to make improvements based on the analysis of usage data made by users.

- <u>Behavioural advertising cookies:</u> these are those that store information on user behaviour obtained through the continuous observation of their browsing habits, which allows the development of a specific profile to display advertising based on it.
